ABOUT THE YOUTH AMBASSADOR PROGRAM is a leadership program that allows youth to interface with the community in order to identify and respond to pressing social issues, such as racial inequity, lack of health access, etc.

REQUIREMENTS – Ambassadors will complete the following during a 6-month period:

- Plan, organize, and execute three (3) community events at a designated Gurdwara in the East Bay (ex. guest speaker events, know your rights outreach, etc.)
- Assist in resource creation, data collection, and community interviews
- Co-write a final report on barriers encountered by the community & possible solutions
- Commit an average of 20 hours per month to complete the activities above

Fluency in Punjabi is highly preferred, but not required.

COMPENSATION

Youth selected to serve as ambassadors will received a stipend of \$2,500, in addition to valuable leadership experience and mentorship from SFC.
